## Article 1.19 STRIKES AND LOCK-OUTS

The parties agree that there shall be no strikes or lock-out for the duration of this agreement.

1.0 Animal Holding, Culture Collection and Liquid Nitrogen Facilities
In the event of a strike or lock-out, employees shall be allowed access to
certain University facilities in order to prevent irreparable damage to ongoing
research and/or materials for teaching such as damage to plant and animal life,
loss of live and/or decomposable materials, damage to equipment or supplies, or
loss of non-repeatable research in progress. Facilities shall include but are
not limited to the Animal Holding Facility, the Culture Collection, and the
Liquid Nitrogen Facility. Employees needing access shall indicate their access
requirements with justification in writing to the Association and the Academic
Vice President in advance of or at the time of any strike or lock-out. The
parties shall meet in a timely manner to review and approve such requests.
